If we don't act now on a scale equal to the problem, our children and future generations will suffer the consequences of our inaction."

Mr Ewings studied archaeology and paleoanthroplogy and is now employed assessing and managing renewable energy programmes in Australia. He stated that his archaeological studies have provided insight into how humans have repeatedly overexploited the world's natural resources. "We are running out of niches to move into", argues Ewings, "we simply cannot afford to ignore the overwhelming scientific evidence of climate change. The <u>3 Step Climate Action Plan</u> is about leaving our children with a planet that isn't an ecological disaster".

Global-Greenhouse-Warming.com is as a comprehensive online resource on climate change available to the general public, schoolteachers, and children.
